The following pages will show the activity of the Wahoo Police Department during the 2021 calendar year. This report gives a visual outline of the calls for service.

The past year was a very challenging year for the Wahoo Police Department. With the ongoing COVID pandemic giving us the Delta variant and then a second wave with the Omicron variant, dealing with the public was a constant give and take. We also lost two officers during the year, which caused our hours in service to rise substantially.

Some of the numbers that are in the report will show a downward trend in areas, and an upward trend in other areas. These up and down spikes do not in any way show that crime in Wahoo is moving at all. Some of the numbers differ from 2020 due to more mobility by the general public. We saw a slight increase in motor vehicle accidents in 2021 as compared to 2020, which might leave you to believe that there are more vehicles traveling on the streets and roads. We saw a marked decrease in the number of traffic citations in 2021, but the traffic warning numbers were almost the same as 2020, and this might lead you to believe that there were fewer vehicles traveling on the streets and roads.

All these numbers are only relative to 2021 and given a year-by-year comparison we would find that the numbers stay fairly consistent throughout the years. This is not to say that we can't in some ways make a difference. I have seen in the past 33 years that the number of alcohol related driving issues have gone down. This was accomplished in two ways, strict enforcement of the laws and a steady education of the public on the dangers of alcohol and driving.

In 2022 the Wahoo Police Department will continue to enforce the Wahoo City Ordinances and the State of Nebraska Statutes in accordance with the Nebraska State moto "Equality before the Law".






CALLS BY MONTH








INCIDENT STATS- THEFT






